PLEASE READ CAREFULLY!

I understand that any dog I obtain will not be perfect. I must give my new dog plenty of time to adjust. The adjustment period could be anywhere from one month to 6 months, sometimes longer. I will be required to spend a lot of time and energy training and exercising my new dog. It will be necessary for me to teach him the rules of the home if I expect him to adjust properly. I will not expose him to lots of new people, places or pets until he has had the opportunity to become comfortable with his new surroundings and family. He must not be exposed to strangers and especially children until I have formed a bond with him and am fully aware of his temperament so as not to put anyone in danger. Dogs are animals and therefore unpredictable. I will be careful and patient.
